DAY 2: WHO YOU REALLY ARE

Read Psalm 139:14

Grades, sports, and friends can all try to define you. But none of those things tells you the most important truth about you—you are made in the image of God. That means your value doesn't come from what you do. It comes from who made you. God created you on purpose and for a purpose. He designed you to reflect what He is like. When you remember who you are, it changes how you live.

DAY 3: REFLECTING GOD

Read 2 Corinthians 3:18

Have you ever made a silly face in the mirror? When you look in a mirror, it reflects whatever you do. Smile, and it smiles back. Make a weird face, and it reflects it back. The Bible says your life is kind of like a mirror. As you follow Jesus, your life begins to reflect Him. That means people can see what God is like by the way you live. But here's the cool part: You don't change yourself on your own. God is the one changing you from the inside out. Little by little, He helps you to look more like Jesus every day.

At-Home Activity: Grab a partner. One person is the "leader," and the other is the "mirror." Copy every movement they make for 30 seconds. Then switch! After, ask yourself: "What would it look like to do what Jesus says and does today?"

DAY 4: GOD WORKS IN YOU

Read Philippians 2:13

Have you ever tried to do the right thing, but it felt really hard? Maybe you wanted to be kind, but you were annoyed. Maybe you wanted to tell the truth, but it was scary. Here's the amazing truth: You aren't doing this on your own. God is working in you. That means He is helping you want to do what is right, and He is giving you the power to actually do it. You don't have to rely on yourself. You can trust Him. God is the One who does the impossible. Your part is to say yes. When you feel stuck, pause and remember: "God, You are working in me right now."

At-Home Activity: For the next hour, every time you feel prompted to do something good (help, be kind, tell the

truth), quietly say: “YES, God!” and do it right away. See how many times you can say yes!

DAY 5: BECOMING LIKE JESUS

Read Colossians 3:10

God made you in His image, and He is helping you grow to be more like Jesus every day. Jesus shows us exactly what God is like. He is loving, kind, patient, and truthful. When you follow Him, your life starts to look more like His. You don't have to do this alone. God's Spirit is with you, helping you change from the inside out. You might not see big changes right away, and that's okay. God is still working. Every time you choose to follow Jesus, you are becoming more like Him. That is how God's image shines through you.

Prayer: “Dear God, thank You for making me in Your image. Help me to remember every single day that the way You made me is amazing and wonderful. Help me trust You to change me and grow me. Show me how to be more like Jesus today. Amen.”
