DAY 3: DIFFERENT GIFTS, SAME KING

1 Corinthians 12:4–6 NlrV

Not everyone gets the same gifts. And that's a good thing. Some people lead. Some people encourage. Some people serve quietly. Some people create. God's kingdom grows when everyone uses what they've been given. You don't need someone else's talent. You need yours. Comparison can stop us from growing. So celebrate the gifts God gave YOU. And know that when you use them, you help the whole kingdom thrive.

DAY 4: FAITH OVER FEAR

Read 2 Timothy 1:7 NlrV

Sometimes we don't use our gifts because we're afraid. We may think: What if I fail? What if I look silly? What if I'm not good enough? But God didn't give you a spirit of fear. He gives power, love, and self-control. You don't have to be fearless. You just have to trust God more than your fear. Every small step of courage helps grow His kingdom.

DAY 5: SHINE WHERE YOU ARE

Matthew 5:14–16 NlrV

Jesus calls you the light of the world. That means wherever you go; school, home, practice, you can be a light. You don't have to be perfect or have everything figured out. You just have to shine. When you choose kindness, speak truth, include others, or stand up for what's right, your light shines bright. Sometimes it can feel easier to blend in or stay quiet. But light isn't meant to be hidden. It's meant to be seen. When you live out your faith in everyday moments, people notice and it points them to God. You don't have to wait until you're older, smarter, or "better." You can shine right now, exactly where you are.
